Upon issuance of either the employment authorization or lawful permanent residency, the Employer must hire the foreign national as a W-2 employee on a full-time, ongoing and long-term basis.

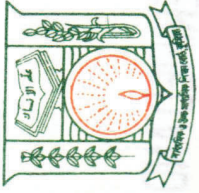
